

## Gods, Heroes and Men of Ancient Greece- Summer Reading Assignment

**Directions:** Read chapters I-X of Gods, Heroes and Men of Ancient Greece. As you read you must outline each chapter using the format provided. The first outlined chapter is provided and you must use this as a template.

During the first weeks of school you will have a test on this assignment. You may use these outlines on the test.

Things to remember when outlining:

- Each chapter's outline should begin with a title, as illustrated in the example.
- Each main topic, considered a heading, is indicated with a Roman numeral.
- Each portion of the main topic, or subheading, should be indented and indicated with a capital letter.
- Each detail of the subheading should be indented and indicated with a number. More specific details should be indented and indicated with lowercase letters. (\* These sections of the outline should contain the bulk of your notes.)
- Each note should be concise; avoid complete sentences.
- Focus on the following:
  - ☞ Main characters
  - ☞ Setting
  - ☞ Summary
  - ☞ Theme
