## P E R S O N N E L   A N D   C U R R I C U L U M

Following are highlights of action taken at the Board meeting for matters of Personnel and Curriculum.

- The Board approved the hiring of Kaitlin Servini as a leave replacement Spanish Teacher from November 1, 2006 through January 26, 2007.
- The Board approved the hiring of Justin Biggs as an English Teacher for the 2006-07 School Year.
- The Board approved the hiring of Annie Murray as a Mathematics Teacher for the 2006-07 School Year.
- The Board approved the movement of teaching staff on the salary guide due to the completion of graduate credits for the 2006-07 School Year.

- The Board approved an increase in hours for Kellyann Maratta, Spanish Teacher, from 2/3 time to full time due to increased course enrollment.

- The Board approved an increase in hours for Camille Thompson, Visual Performing Arts Teacher, from 1/2 time to 2/3 time due to increased course enrollment.

- The Board approved an increase in hours for Maureen Bjelka-Kovach, Mathematics Teacher, from 2/3 time to full time due to increased course enrollment.

- The Board approved additional Out of District Special Education placements for the 2006-07 School Year.

- The Board approved additional Fall 2006 Coaching recommendations.

- The Board approved additional 2006-07 Activities Advisor recommendations.

- The Board approved the initial 2006-07 School Year substitute teacher list.

- The Board approved the creation of a Girls' Tennis Assistant Coach for 2006-07 due to the large number of participating students.

## F I N A N C E   A N D   F A C I L I T I E S

- The district approved the payment of bills for the month of August.
