## P E R S O N N E L A N D C U R R I C U L U M

Following are highlights of action taken at the Board meeting for matters of Personnel and Curriculum.

- The Board approved the hiring of Christine O'Rourke as a tutor in the mathematics lab for four days a week and three hours a day.
- The Board approved the hiring of William Brown as a maintenance staff member for the 2006-07 School Year.
- The Board approved a change in title for Peter Grandinetti, from Coordinator of Business Education and Vocational-Technical Education to Supervisor of Business Education, Vocational-Technical Education,

and Family and Consumer Sciences for the 2006-07 School Year.

- The Board approved the movement of teaching staff on the salary guide due to the completion of graduate credits for the 2006-07 School Year.
- The Board approved the application for reimbursement of graduate tuition costs to teaching staff who are taking graduate course work.
- The Board approved payment to staff members who underwent IDE, SIOP and In-Class Support professional development training over the summer.

- The Board approved the preliminary June 2006 Treasurers Report and Secretary's Financial Report.
- The Board approved the use of the facilities by the Red Bank CROP Walk for the Hungry and the Little Silver PTO 5K Road Race and Kids Fun Run both scheduled for October 15, 2006.
- The Board approved travel requests by employees and Board members for travel occurring in October and November 2006.
- The Board rejected all bids
