Code of Conduct for Extra-Curricular Activities/Athletics

Red Bank Regional High School encourages all students to take advantage of the school sponsored extra-curricular activities. Both Red Bank Regional High School and the community take great pride in these programs that are designed to enhance the well balanced educational programs offered.

Rationale: Participating in extracurricular activities and representing Red Bank Regional High School is a privilege, not a right. Students participating in performance-based activities act as representatives of the school district. Accordingly, they are expected to conform their conduct at all times to the highest standards. Participants make a commitment to their peers and coaches/advisors to follow rules and to be able to perform at their best at all times. One of the primary goals of the extra-curricular programs at Red Bank Regional High School is to provide students with the lessons and skills necessary for success not only on the athletic field or performance stage, but also in all areas of their lives. In addition, they have a responsibility to serve as role models for other students in the school, as well as for others in the community. Participants, whether in or out of uniform, carry with them not only their own reputations, but that of their families, their team/activity, and their school.

Applies to: All students attending Red Bank Regional High School who participate in extra-curricular activities. These activities are defined by performance participation that occurs outside of school and which no grade is given. If students and parents are unsure if a specific activity is covered by this policy, questions should be directed to the administration.

Applies When: The first time in an individual's high school career that a student becomes a member of an extracurricular activity, the Extra-Curricular Code of Conduct becomes active. The Code of Conduct is in effect twelve months of the year, seven days a week, twenty-four hours a day, in and out of season, on and off school grounds, until graduation.

Every member of each Red Bank Regional extra-curricular activity is expected to maintain lawful conduct, and the high ideals of personal integrity and loyalty. To effectuate Red Bank Regional's commitment to that goal, each student must adhere, to the following rules. (by signing this document participants acknowledge an understanding of these expectations):

1. A member of an extra-curricular activity is prohibited from the use and/or possession of alcoholic beverages or controlled Performance-enhancing substances as defined by New Jersey law. Students may be disciplined for being in the presence of others who engage in the illegal use of such substances.
2. A student shall not engage in activities, which constitute criminal offences or juvenile delinquency as defined by law.
3. In addition to the other provisions of the Student Handbook and the discretionary authority of the School District Official to discipline, students violating the above rules during the in-season period as defined by the NJSIAA/School District may be removed from the activity which he or she is a member for the remainder of that season.
4. A violation of these rules may also result in the referral to the Student Assistance Counselor.

We have read the above rules and hereby agree to comply with them. We understand that a violation of these rules will subject the undersigned pupil to disqualification from participation in an extra-curricular activity.
