Admissions Guidelines/Testing requirement

Admission of eighth grade students applying to the academy programs will be based a combination of standardized test scores (NJASK7 or other comparable test), “in-house testing” provided by RBRHS, grades, attendance and various other factors. NJASK8 scores will not be released until June and are too late to consider for the upcoming school year. Upperclassmen applying to the academy must submit their most recent test scores in lieu of NJASK7. These scores are available from your school counselor or the Principal’s office where you presently attend school. It is the applicants’ responsibility to request copies of test scores and transcripts.

Academic performance, Report Cards, Transcripts and Attendance Information

This documentation is available from your school counselor or the Principals’ office where you presently attend school. You must request a copy from them. Please give them enough time to provide the information we need to process your application.
