## Summer Assignments for AP US History

Introduction: The AP US History course is a demanding one that requires heavy reading and writing. The course moves at a fast pace because of the amount of material to be learned. Students <u>MUST</u> have a good work ethic and be an independent learner to succeed in the class.

Students should have attended the AP Fair to receive their textbook (*American Pageant 16<sup>th</sup> edition*) and information about the course. Each student was asked to come after school to complete the registration process to access the online readings and activities to be completed this summer. If a student did not attend the fair or see me before the end of the year, they **MUST email me for information on picking up book and registering for the online program.** 

The online program is called MindTap. All the assignments, including assessments will be posted there with **DUE DATES**. Students will be reading 2 chapters and completing activities/assessments associated with text. Students will be reading historical essays and commenting on the articles. *All students* enrolled in the AP US History course are responsible for completing assignments on time. If work is submitted late, a 10 point penalty will be assessed for each day late.
