5.1 ADOPTION OF THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR BUDGET AND TAX LEVY

WHEREAS, the Red Bank Regional Board of Education adopted a tentative budget on March 18, 2020 to be submitted to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools for approval, and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was approved by the Executive County Superintendent of Schools on April 3, 2020 and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was advertised in the legal section of the Asbury Park Press on April 17, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget was presented to the public during a public hearing on April 29, 2020; and

Budget Adjustment – Enrollment 2020-2021

Resolved that the Red Bank Regional Board of Education includes in the proposed budget the adjustment for enrollment in the amount of \$478,650. The district intends to utilize this adjustment for instruction necessary for additional students, and

Maintenance Reserve Account Withdrawal 2020-2021

Resolved that the Red Bank Regional Board of Education approves a Maintenance Reserve withdrawal in the amount of \$200,000. The district intends to utilize these funds for maintenance expenditures in the same amount from account 11-000-261-420, and

Banked Cap Adjustment – 2020-2021 Budget

Resolved that the Red Bank Regional Board of Education includes in the proposed budget the adjustment for banked cap in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6a:23a-10.3(b). The District has fully exhausted all eligible statutory spending authority and must increase the base budget in the amount of \$297,127 for the following purposes to be completed by the end of the 2020-2021 school year:

- 1. Expand the alternative education program for at risk students in grades nine through 12.
- 2. Improve technology including continuing the one to one initiative and expanding connectivity.
- 3. School security improvements including communication and monitoring facilities, and,

<u>Travel and Related Expense Reimbursement 2020-2021</u>

WHEREAS, the Red Bank Regional Board of Education recognizes school staff and Board members will incur travel expenses related to and within the scope of their current responsibilities and for travel that promotes the delivery of instruction or furthers the efficient

operation of the school district; and

Whereas, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.2 et seq. requires Board members to receive approval of these expenses by a majority of the full voting membership of the Board and staff members to receive prior approval of these expenses by the Superintendent of Schools and a majority of the full voting membership of the Board; and

Whereas, a Board of Education may establish, for regular district business travel as defined in NJAC 6A:23A-1.2, which includes attendance at regularly scheduled in-State county meetings, Department or Association sponsored events or in-State professional development activities for which the registration fee does not exceed \$150 per employee or board member, where prior Board approval shall not be required unless the annual threshold for a staff member exceeds \$1,500 in a given school year (July 1 through June 30); and

Therefore, be It resolved, the Board of Education approves travel and related expense reimbursements in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A: 23A-7.3, to a maximum expenditure of \$75,000 for all staff and board members for the 2020-2021 school year, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the budget be adopted for the 2020-2021 school year using the 2020-2021 state aid figures and the Secretary to the Board of Education be authorized to submit the following adopted budget to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools in accordance with the statutory deadline:
