# Early decision vs. Early action

- What's the difference between the two?
  - ☞ Early decision = Binding
  - ☞ Early action = will get decision back sooner
- Early Decision should be reserved for 'dream schools.' - Financial Need not considered.

Reminder: Please give the office two weeks to process your application for early action or early decision-see your counselor about this option!

# Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF)

The New Jersey Educational Opportunity Fund provides financial assistance and support services (e.g. counseling, tutoring, and developmental course work) to students from educationally and economically disadvantaged backgrounds who attend institutions of higher education in the State of New Jersey.

Forty-two of New Jersey's community colleges and public and private four-year colleges and universities participate in the EOF program. However, the actual number of available spaces at each college or university is limited. Because EOF is a campus-based program, each campus is responsible for student recruitment, selection, program services, and its own specific criteria for EOF admission and program participation.

## First Steps:

- Update list of colleges you are interested in applying to under the “College” tab on Naviance
- Update resume and complete Self-Assessment under the “About Me” tab on Naviance
- Create account online at [www.commonapp.org](http://www.commonapp.org) or <http://www.coalitionforcollegeaccess.org> and with any other colleges that are NOT Common App
- Complete FERPA waiver on your Common App so we can assist with matching it to your Naviance account
- Work on filling out online applications

# Next steps when Applying:

- Request teacher & counselor recommendations
- Submit College Application Processing Forms to Guidance
- Submit Transcript Release Form and Rank Reporting Form
- Submit resume and self-assessment to counselor



# Applying continued...

- **Deadlines**

- All required materials must be submitted to Guidance 2 weeks before the college's deadline (although you may bring them earlier)
- To have your applications and support materials submitted by Thanksgiving recess, you must bring all required materials to Guidance by November 9, 2018; applications to be sent by the winter break must be submitted to Guidance by December 9, 2018.
- When you are ready to submit application requests, it is mandatory that you make an appointment with your counselor.
- **DON'T FORGET** the supplemental materials esp. for RUTGERS & PENN STATE SRAR (Self-Reported Academic Record)
