This enriching, college experience provides students with opportunities to create individual work, collaborate with other high school students from around the world, and participate in field trips which may include Broadway and off-Broadway shows, museums, galleries, film screenings, or concerts.

ADMISSIONS

Students must be current high school juniors or sophomores (rising seniors or juniors) to apply. The filmmaking track is only open to juniors. All applicants must have a 3.0 minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) on a 4.0 unweighted scale and be in good academic standing. Students must submit the online program application and additional admissions materials. Admitted students must live in NYU assigned housing and are not be permitted to commute / live with family or friends on or off-campus during the program.
